The Chandler Symphony Orchestra has been serving the Greater Chandler area since 1993 with the finest in classical music, free of charge to the public. One hundred professionally trained volunteer musicians perform five Classics concerts and a Pops concert each year, on the main stage of the Chandler Center of the Arts. We will also perform two Chamber Music concerts to a smaller audience, now at the Chandler Community Center. All concerts are well attended by a loyal audience, sometimes filling every seat.

You can take advantage of this audience by purchasing advertising space in our concert program. Ads are available for \$250 to \$2,500 for an entire season, and creation of your ad is included in this price, should you need it. Our programs are high quality, professionally produced booklets which are read through several times during a concert, then taken home by upwards of 6,500 individuals in our community between September and May each year. Along with the concert's music listing and program notes, this audience views local businesses with whom they might need or want to engage with on a daily basis. *Shouldn't this be you?*
